## CHRONOLOGICAL NARRATIVE COMBAT OPERATIONS

## CHRONOLOGICAL NARRATIVE COMBAT OPERATIONS NOVEMBER 1944

During the month of November only two missions were flown by the 89th Bomberdment Squedron (L), totalling 12 combat sorties with 9 tons of bombs dropped on target and nil ammunition expended in strafing.(1) (Plate I)


One B-25J was lost to the squadron through transfer, but at the end of November the squadron still had the same 16 A-20Gs. A total of 64:25 combat hours were flown. (2).

On 1 November the target was the A/A positions in vicinity of 8W (Babo Drome). 9 A-20Gs and 1 B-25 dropped 36 x 500 lb. 1/10 second delay demos in assigned target area between positions 8W and the hospital. Damage could not be assessed due to excessive dirt clouds caused by exploding bombs. (3).

On 3 November the 89th flew a photo mission on Utarom Strip. Two planes reached the target and made one run on each strip, the first run at 7100 feet and the second run at 7400 feet. Nil bombs were dropped and nil ammunition was expended. (4).
