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SECTION I

CHRONILOGICAL NARRATIVE

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CHRONOLOGICAL NARRATIVE
COMBAT OPERATIONS
OCTOBER 1944

During the month of October, 9 missions were flown by the 89th Bombardment Squadron (L), totaling 97 sorties with 37.2 tons of bombs dropped on targets, 36,300 rounds of .50 calibre ammunition expended in strafing and 1.95 tons of bombs jettisoned. (1) These compilations show a decrease of 37 sorties, a decrease of 13.5 tons of bombs dropped and an increase of 21,800 rounds of ammunition expended in strafing as compared to the operations carried out by this squadron during the month of September. The decrease in bombs dropped and increase of ammunition expended is due to three low altitude missions being flown this month as compared to one in September. The 9 missions flown include 5 medium altitude bombing missions, 3 minimum altitude bombing and strafing missions, and 1 medium altitude bombing mission on which the planes were above the target but returned due to weather. Utarom Drome was hardest hit. (Plate I)


Sixteen A-20Gs were assigned to the Squadron on 1 October and the same number were in commission on 31 October. One B-25-J was added to the Squadron during this period. (2) One pilot was fatally burned when he crashed while taking off due to the nose wheel giving way. One pilot was lost while on a cross country flight to Nadzab.

The first mission of the month was flown by 9 planes on 1 October to Utarom Drome on the South coast of Dutch New Guinea. The A-20s dropped a total of 35 x 500# bombs on the vertex of both strips and extending up each approximately 1500 feet. About 50% of the bombs landed on the strips and the remainder in the immediate vicinity. (3)

The A/A positions West of Babo Strip were the target for 13 planes on 4 October. 12 A-20s returned due to weather after reaching a point approximately 75 miles East of Babo. However, 1 B-25 dropped 4 x 500# bombs on Babo Drome. Damage could not be assessed due to cloud cover. One burst of heavy A/A was seen trailing and above plane. (4)

The first minimum altitude bombing and strafing mission of the month was flown on 5 October by 11 A-20s which dropped a total of 57 x 100# 4/5 second delay fused bombs on the Bivouac Area, SE Sarmi and expended 17,500 x .50 calibre ammunition in strafing. The target was well strafed, 3 huts were set on fire, and one active W/G was destroyed by a direct hit. (5)

Combat Operations, October 1944, Cont'd.

The target on 8 October was Utarom strip. 11 A-20s failed to reach the target due to weather, but 1 B-25 at medium altitude dropped 4 x 500lb bombs which were seen to burst at the intersection of the strips. Nil other damage could be assessed. (1)

On 10 October 4 A-20s flew a minimum altitude bombing and strafing mission at the enemy Bivouac Area at mouth of Natoe River in Sarmi Area. 32 x 100# 8-15 second delay fused para-demos were dropped and 5,900 x .50 calibre ammunition were expended in strafing. The only damage that could be assessed was the setting of one or two huts on fire. One of our pilots was fatally burned in crashing on the take-off. (2)

Babo Strip was again the target for 8 A-20s and 1 B-25 on a medium altitude mission on 15 October. All planes returned due to heavy clouds after reaching a point above the target. (3)

The third mission to Utara Strip was flown on 19 October by 9 A-20s from medium altitude. A total of 34 x 500, 1/10 second delay bombs were dropped and seen to burst in the camp and bivouac area 100 to 300 yards South of Number 2 runway. A fire was started and white smoke was seen to rise to 500 feet. (4)

The third mission to Sarmi was conducted on 23 October at minimum altitude by 9 A-20s. 60 x 100/4/5 second delay bombs were dropped and seen to burst along the Trai River. One hut was blown up, and 2 bombs were dropped on a L/G position with unobserved results. 12,900 x .50 calibre ammunition was expended in strafing the entire area. Moderate L/G fire was encountered with one plane being holed. (5)

Utarom Strip was the target again at medium altitude on 26 October. 11 A-20s and 1 B-25 reached the target and dropped 42 x 500# 1/10 second delay bombs over the target area. Damage could not be assessed due to cloud cover over the target. (6)

The final mission of the month was to bomb the A/A positions SE of Babo Strip from medium altitude on 31 October. All planes were forced to turn back due to weather. (7)

Capt. James L. Folse and 1st Lt. Jack B. Craig left the Squadron this month to begin their "Commando Training" in the States. 1st Lt. Gordon P. Messerlie is still sweating out a boat headed for that much looked-for sight, the Golden Gate and San Francisco.

The Squadron had a couple of tough breaks this month in losing Capt. William W. Neel and 2nd Lt. Jack B. Conway. Capt. Neel was killed on a cross-country flight to Nadzab when he crashed into the side of a mountain during bad weather. Lt. Conway was fatally burned when he crashed while taking off due to his nose wheel giving way.

Several new items of sports equipment have been acquired in the Officer's Area. A small area has been cleared and Lt. Mosley built a basket-ball court which has been very enthusiastically received. Two new sets of horseshoes have been acquired, so interest in this game has also increased. Besides the above named equipment, the Officers have a punching bag, volley ball, and baseball equipment.


