CHRONOLOGICAL NARRATIVE
COMBAT OPERATIONS
JANUARY 1945

During the month of January, 7 missions were flown by the 89th Bombardment Squadron (L), totalling 65 combat sorties with 28.3 tons of bombs dropped on targets, 59,920 rounds of .50 calibre ammunition expended in strafing and 1 1/8 tons of bombs jettisoned. (1)

The strength in number of airplanes was still 16 A-20Gs at the end of January. One plane was lost through transfer and one plane was received through transfer. (2)

The first mission for the 89th Squadron in January, and the first since 3 November 1944, was to bomb and strafe enemy defense positions on hill 4 miles SE of Rosario Village with 8 planes. Secondary target, Carabao Island in Manila Bay. 32 x 250 lb. 4-5 second delay demos and 16 x 100 lb. Napalm bombs were dropped on the target well covering the entire ridge and west slope and partially covering the east slope of the hill. The whole target was covered with gray white and black smoke, making assessment of damage impossible. (3)

On 26 January 9 A-20Gs of the squadron found their target was Tuguegarao Airdrome, a road sweep from Belete Pass to Tuguegarao, a road sweep from San Fernando to Manila restricted area, and as a last resort, Carabao Island. The road sweep from Belete Pass to Tuguegarao was made without incident - no activity was seen. On Tuguegarao a total of 50 x 100 lb. demos were dropped with bursts seen on field, but other than one small shack being destroyed, nil damage was observed. One truck was strafed on return trip, and 22 bombs were dropped in vicinity of Pleridel Field, probably destroying 2 of 3 enemy probable SE dummies. Carabao Island was bombed and strafed with unobserved results. (4)

On 27 January the target for 9 A-20Gs was Aparri Airdrome, road network in east Bataan, and Carabao Island. 19 x 250 lb. 4-5 second delay parademos were seen to hit Aparri, further damaging several u/s enemy aircraft on the strip. 8 x 250 lb. 4-5 second delay parademos were dropped on Carabao Island, hitting an empty gun pit and the wooden barracks. Smoke was seen rising above the island after the attack. Enemy interception was encountered by 3 probable Tojos two miles east of Tuguegarao. One probable Tojo was seen behind our 3 flights as we were leaving Aparri. These two encounters occurred so quickly that only one of our rear gunners fired his guns, with nil results. (5)

Combat Operations, January 1945, Contd.

On 28 January the Squadron (9 planes) was to bomb Echague, but due to bad weather the only target hit was Carabao Island. The barracks area and small shacks east and south of this area were bombed with 25 x 250 lb. 4-5 second delay parademos and 12 x 100 lb. Napalm bombs, causing fires and smoke which rose to 60 ft. above the island. (6)

Taguegarao Airdrome was the target on 29 January for 8 A-20Gs. 516 x 23 lb. parafrags and 18 x 100 lb. Napalm bombs were dropped on Taguegarao strip, barracks area SW of strip, and the huts east and west of strip. Two large fires and several smaller ones were started in barracks area and the east and west edges of the strip. One A-20 bombed and strafed Carabao Island with unobserved results. (7)

On 30 January, 10 planes conducted a road and coastal sweep from Batangas Airdrome to Catansuan Airdrome, North Tayabas Bay. 41 x 100 lb. 4-5 second delay parademos were dropped on a lugger 100 yards south of Catansuan. Heavy damage was inflicted on this boat. Very little activity was noted. (8)

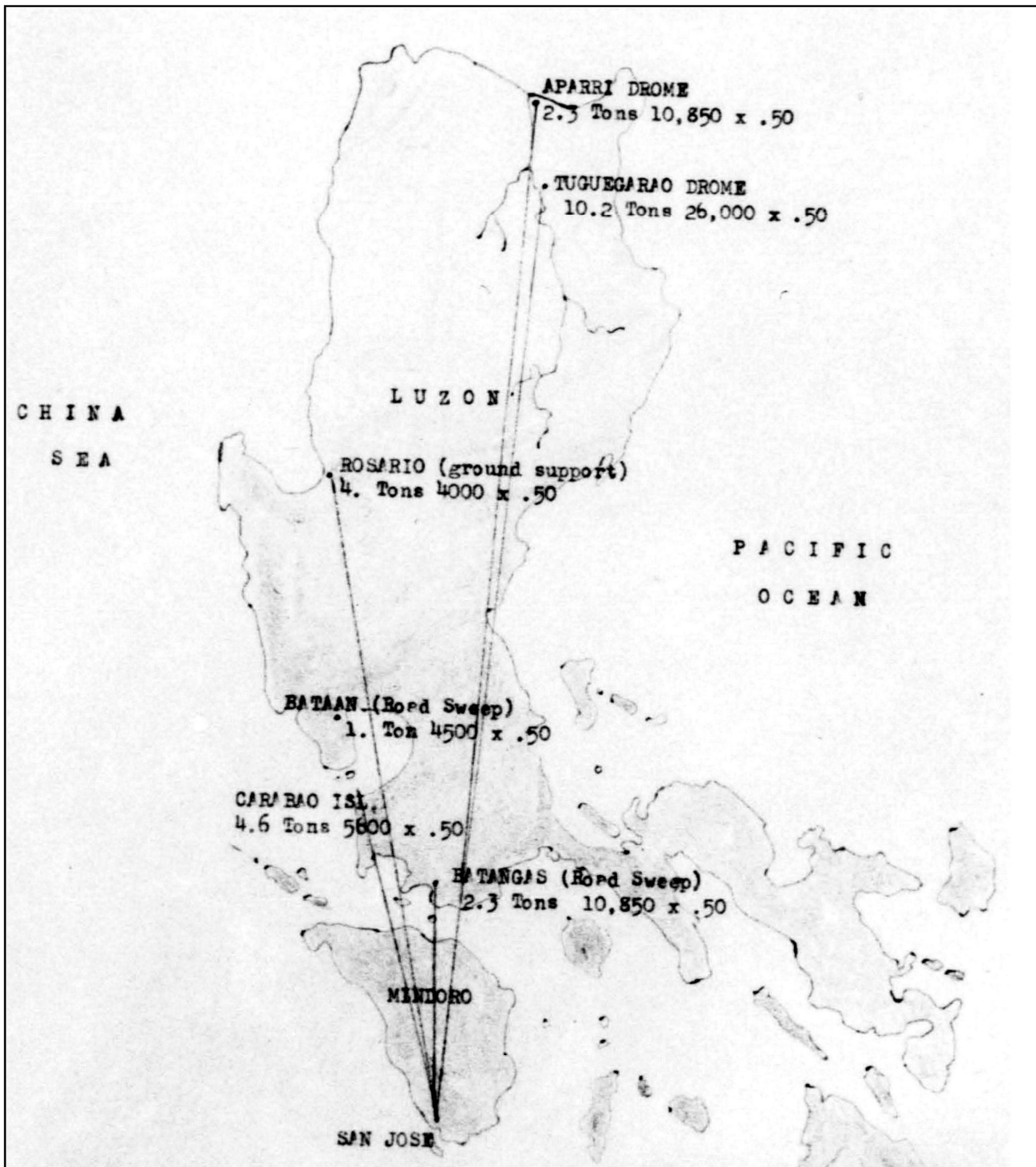
The last mission in January, on the 31st, was a 6 plane road sweep from NW tip of Lake Taal covering highways #17 and #25, and roads between. 15 x 100 lb. 4-5 second delay parademos were dropped in the vicinity of Genlaly. One bomb hit railroad track and one bomb destroyed a box car. Several other railroad cars were strafed in this area. Very little activity was noted during entire road sweep. (9)
